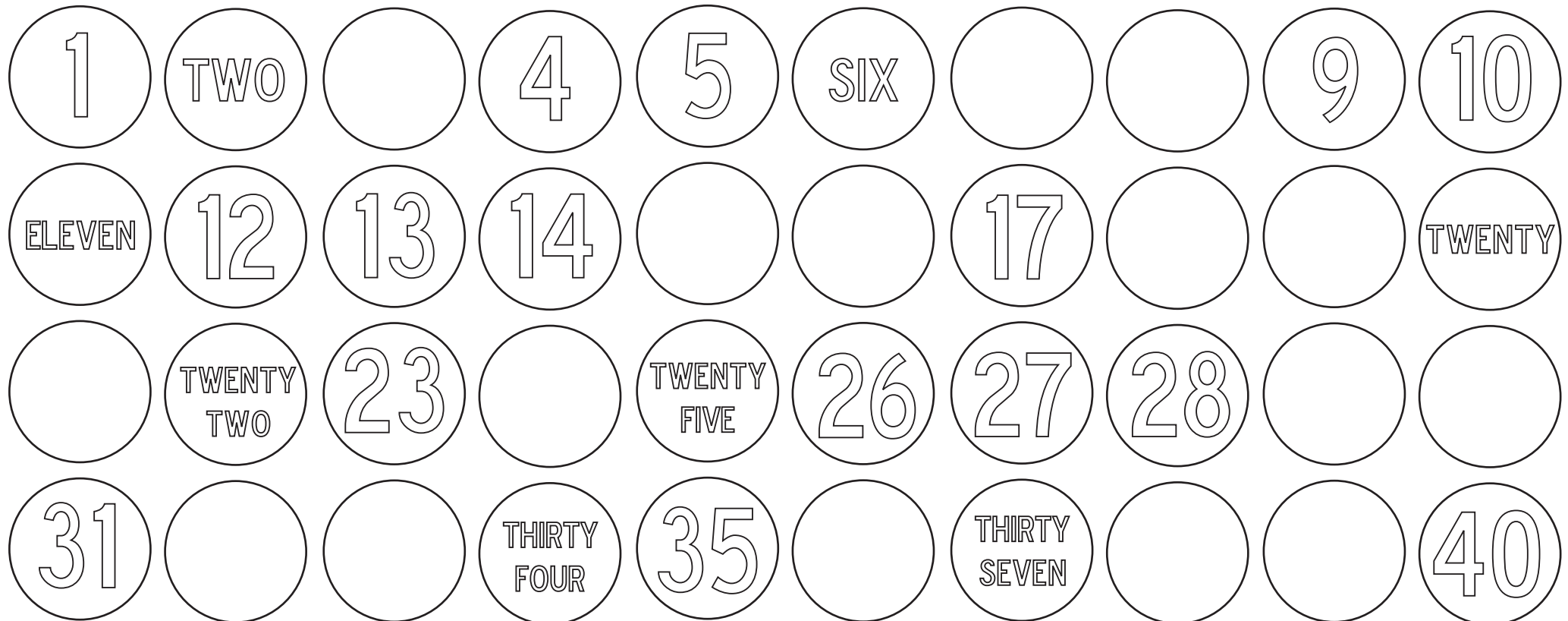


40 DAYS OF PRAYER

WEEK ONE

READ NONHLE'S STORY WITH YOUR FAMILY ONE NIGHT BEFORE DINNER THIS WEEK

Saturday, March 9th - Day 4

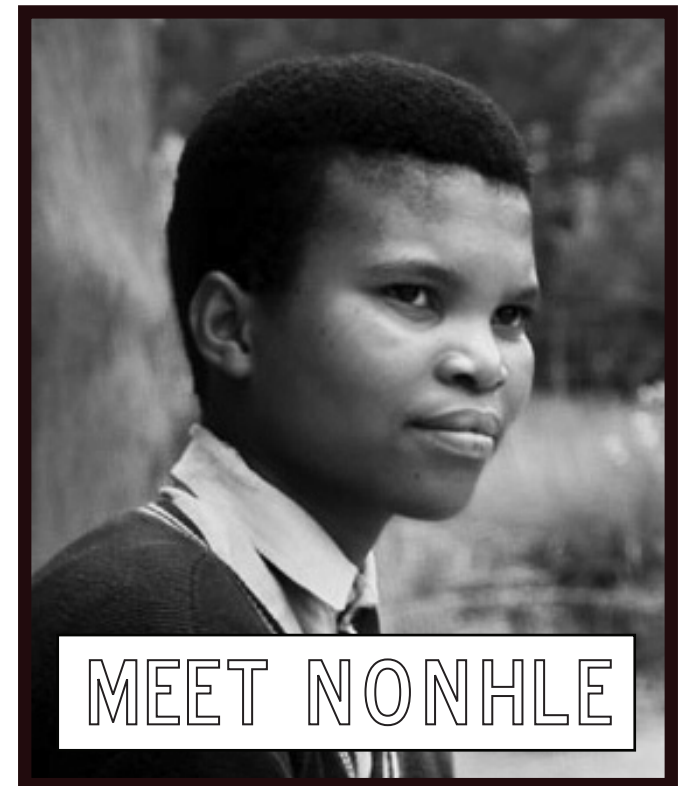
It is wrong for young girls to be married to older men. God, I pray that you would protect girls in places where this happens, and comfort them.

Thursday, March 14th - Day 8

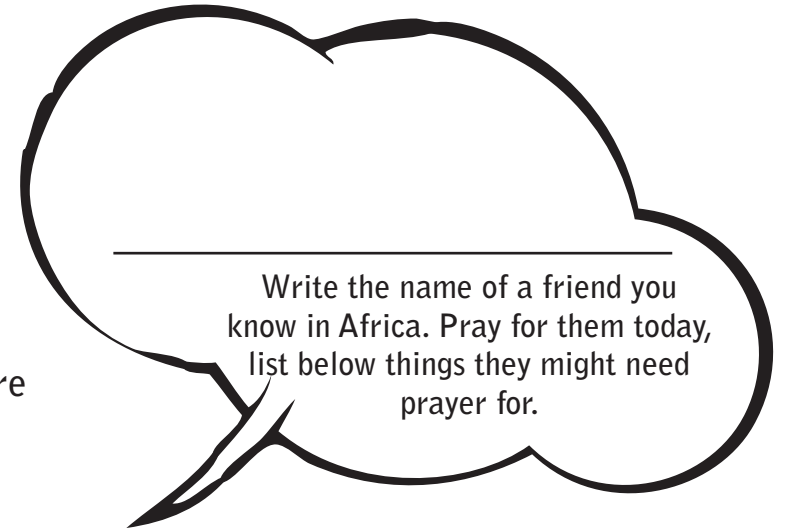
I pray for Hands at Work. Help us to care for children in Africa who need food, shelter and to go to school.

Thank you, God, for loving me. I pray for children in Africa, like Nonchle, to know that You love them.

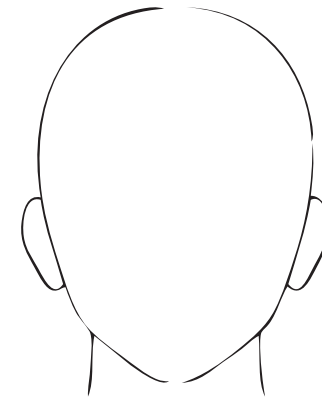
Saturday, March 16th - Day 10

Thursday, March 21st - Day 14

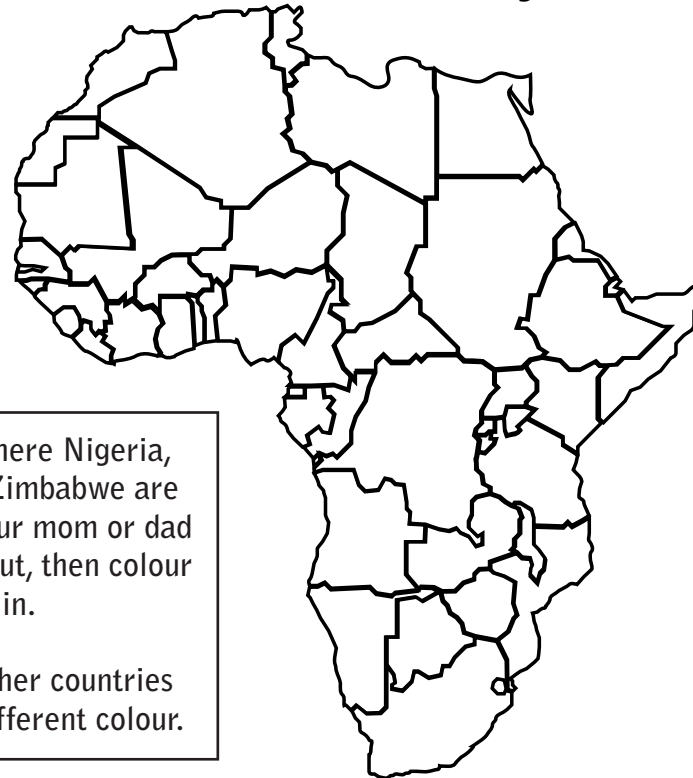
I pray for churches to care for people in their own communities who are poor. Please help the churches to also care for poor people in Africa.

wisdom and unity as they serve the African local Hands at Work teams and the Care Workers.

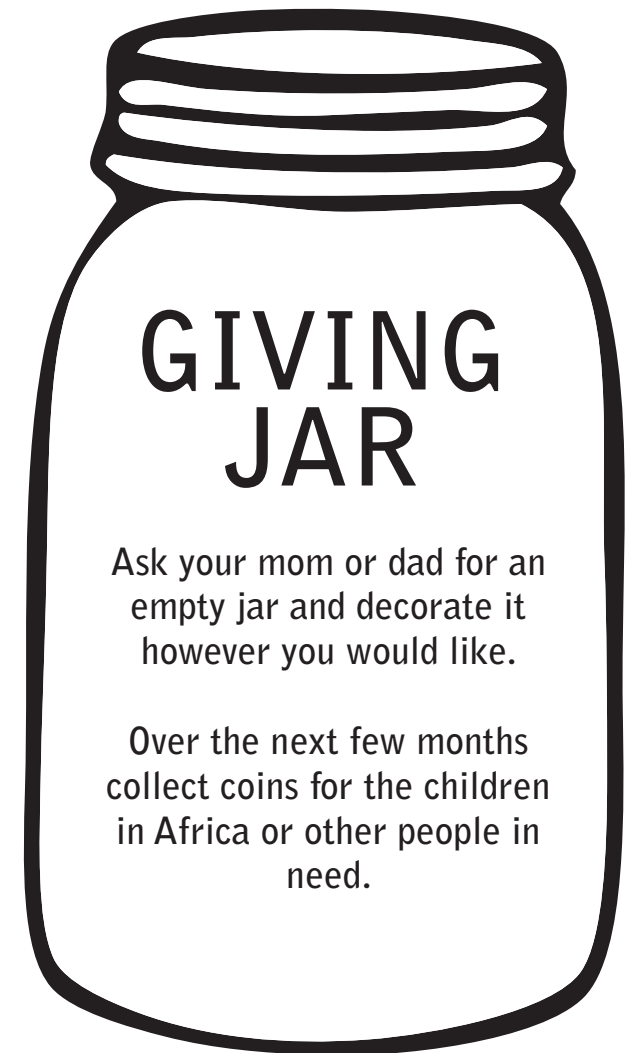
Friday, April 5th - Day 27
